The Bird Aviation Museum & Invention Center opened its doors to the public for the first time on July 7 and 8, 2007. The two day Open House was supported by volunteers from the local aviation community. Some of those volunteers became the first group of Museum Docents – many are still part of the group and many more from all walks of life have joined the group in the succeeding years.

The Docent program operates during the summer season only – Monday through Saturday, 9:00AM to 4:00PM, mid May through mid October. During the winter season, Docents volunteer on an as needed basis when large groups visit the museum. Docent uniforms consist of a red polo shirt and ID badge – provided by the museum – and khaki/tan slacks/shorts/skirts supplied by the Docent.

The museum's collection of artifacts number in the thousands. Though the sheer volume of information may at first seem intimidating, it has all been broken down into bite size pieces in the form of booklets available to the volunteers.
